Reply

(i) NATIONAL DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM

(1) Yes, as per Public Service Handbook for Senior Management Services, the senior management of the department can structure their salary packages to make provision for the payment of a 13th cheque (birthday bonus) in the month they were born.

Three (3) senior officials received their bonuses as per structured salary packages.

- (a) 3 X Chief Directors.
- (b) 3 X R44 264.55 (R132 793.65)
- (2) These bonuses were not performance based, as it is the choice of the senior official to structure his/ her package to receive a 13th cheque. If not structured for a 13th cheque, the amount is part of a monthly non-pensionable allowance.
