Requirements.

- Applicants should be between the age of 18-35.
- Matric with fluency in English or Tourism and Hospitality Qualification (provide certified copies of certificates)

- Proof of residence, and any other relevant certificate/s.
- Beneficiaries who have previously participated in the Department's learnership or skills programmes should declare in the motivational letter.
