## Launch of the Twee Rivieren (Khomani San) Interpretive Centre – Northern Cape Province

On 19 July 2023, the Minister of Tourism Patricia de Lille will launch the Twee Rivieren (±Khomani San) Interpretive Centre at the SANParks' Transfrontier Park in the Northern Cape Province.

The Twee Rivieren ( $\pm$ Khomani San) Interpretive Centre is a collaborative initiative between the Department of Tourism and SANParks to enhance the visitor experience at the Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park World Heritage Site. The Department of Tourism invested R3.5 million into enhancing the site's infrastructure to ensure that the Centre offers an exceptional demonstration of the  $\pm$ Khomani San heritage through interactive exhibitions and presentations.

The ±Khomani Landscape's rich history and heritage is among South Africa's unique cultural offerings making it a must-see destination and experience for all visitors.
