The World Tourism Day Celebrations is a United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) annual initiative that affords countries a day to celebrate the socio-economic milestones of Tourism under a particular theme.

In support of the United Nations International Year of Water Cooperation, WTD 2013 is being held under the theme "Tourism and Water: Protecting our Common Future".
