As the country gathers to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the 1956 Women's March, Women in Tourism will be adding their voices in calling for a non-sexist and equitable industry.

According the United Nations World Tourism Organization's (UNWTO) 2010 'Global report on Women in Tourism,' women make up a large proportion of the formal tourism workforce, and are well represented in service and clerical level – but still earn 10% to 15% less than their male counterparts.
