Applications must be submitted on a Z83 form, obtainable from any Public Service Department, stating the field for which the Intern is applying (from the above list), and attach a CV, certified copies of certificates, academic transcripts (record) and an Identity Document.

Failure to submit the required documents will result in the application not being considered.
