The process for registration has been indicated as follows: Applies to SAQA for recognition as a professional body and to have professional designations registered on the NQF

Has the option to pursue international affiliation, but must still meet local requirements Works with QC(s) in quality assurance and standards setting for formal qualifications registered on the NQF
