A limited number of participation packages have been secured at the ATM 2017 for market access support under the IMASP and is specifically aimed at assisting small to medium tourism enterprises that wish to showcase packaged travel experiences to buyers in the Middle East.

Reimbursement of costs incurred is subject to the following capped amounts:

- Accommodation R 4 226.33 per person per night, linked to the duration of the exhibition
- Flight R 16 159.56, based on an economic class return flight
- Exhibition fees for approved tourism enterprise will be paid by the Department directly to the exhibition organisers.
