The Department of Tourism, through the International Market Access Support Programme (IMASP), invites eligible tourism enterprises to apply and participate in the World Travel Market (WTM) Africa that will be taking place in Cape Town, South Africa from 10 - 12 April 2019.

WTM Africa is an annual vibrant event that welcomes nearly 5 000 attendees from the travel industry globally. Through industry networks, global reach and regional focus, WTM Africa creates personal and business opportunities providing customers with quality contacts, content and communities. The travel industry professionals attend this Africa's leading and only business to business (B2B) exhibition for inbound and outbound Africa travel and tourism markets.

A limited number of enterprises will be supported to participate in the event with a particular focus on small and mediumsize tourism enterprises offering tour operator services; accommodation; attractions; meetings and special events; and experience providers in travel packaging, negotiating and selling relevant tourism packages to international buyers.

In line with the programme guidelines, reimbursement of costs incurred will be based on **capped amounts**:

- Accommodation: Per person per night, linked to the duration of the exhibition;
- Flight Return economy class airfare
- Participation/exhibition fees for approved enterprises will be paid for by the Department directly to the exhibition organiser.

Please also note that if you have been approved three (3) times within five (5) years period and have participated in all three events, you should not submit your application as it will not be considered as per the IMASP Guidelines.
